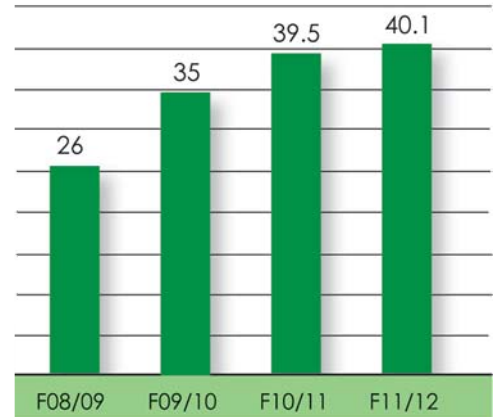


COLLECTING DATA TO EFFECTIVELY MEASURE WASTE DIVERSION AND REDUCTION
